Path Pink

Designated 508, 541

A short linear walk, best taken on a clear day. Can involve a little uphill walking on the return journey.

Start: Turning from A44 into Crown East School

Parking: Opposite the church on Crown East Lane.

Time required: ¾ hours

- 1. Start along the metalled road to the Public Bridle Way gate and a few yards on to the wooden gate.
- 2. Walk southward and take in the 180-degree view of the hills. (Bredon Hill left in the distance and the Malvern Hills directly in front of you).
- 3. Through the next gate and see the Solar Farm. Aim slightly left and down the hillside to the edge of the pond on your left. Aim to the furthest corner of the field to a metal gate with a horse rider friendly latching. If the hillside is a little steep feel free to about turn and retrace your steps (after admiring the views).
- 4. Exit the gate into another field and track around the left edge for about 40 yards (to the corner) and then aim directly towards the wooden telegraph pole (electricity actually)
- 5. At the pole the path kinks left towards a gateway on to the A4103 Bransford Road. This is as far as you go and so turn and retrace your steps. (A44 to A4103 to A44 2 km)
