In relation to anti-social behaviour, I can only search back to January this year, since then we have one incident of ASB recorded.

As you can see crime remains very low. Regardless of this, both Broadwas and Cotheridge are patrolled by the local policing team every day we are on duty, even if it's just the arterial routes.

Over the last year, the local policing team have visited the local primary school and have given educational inputs on firework safety, staying safe during dark mornings/evenings and stranger danger. We have also visited the nursery and have spoken to the little ones about what we do. We have become familiar faces at the school.

Speed monitoring has been conducted by the Safer Neighbourhood Teams and the Road Safety team have visited on a few occasions in the camera van.

On the 7th of May we have a new PCSO joining our area replacing PCSO Knight who is now a response officer at Malvern. PCSO Ash Smith is joining us from Pershore. This will enable us to up our patrols of hot spot areas.
