Report for item 26/115 - A44 Road safety and speeding

We continue to raise our concerns and liaise with our County Councillor and the County Council Highways Liaison Officer.

Developments include

- We have now received from Highways details of the replacement signage resulting from the Road Study in 2024 and work has started. Details have been circulated to members are on the website .
- Our County Councillor continues to raise our concerns and objectives with the Highways Liaison Officer and has also met with new chair of the relevant committee.
- She has kept the Chair updated and we are agreed that we should continue to press for a reduced speed zone through Cotheridge and speed reduction zones either side of Broadwas.
- There was a traffic accident recently in Broadwas.
- The Clerk will update the meeting regarding progress with the instillation of the new VAS in Broadwas.
- There is an agreement that our County and District Councillors and our chair will request a meeting with senior officer from the Police to review their enforcement activity, and our Clerk is organising this.
- The meeting tonight will be considering separately whether further measures can be taken to reduce overgrowth (item 26/118)
- There is no further news on the Councils intention to install new forms of drainage at the bend opposite the entrance to Upper Howson's Farm.
- Speed recorders are in place in Broadwas and Cotheridge, further information needs to be obtained as to the purpose of these.
